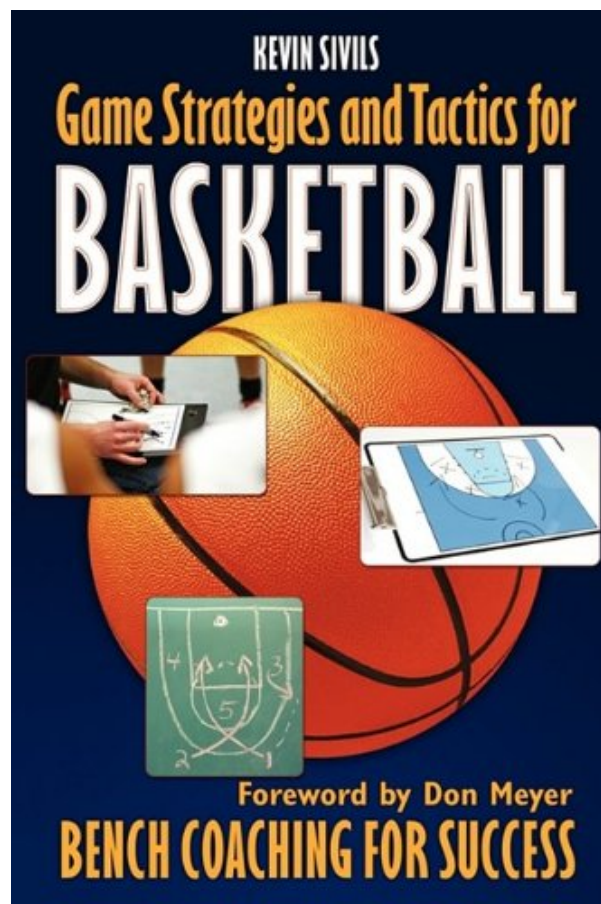
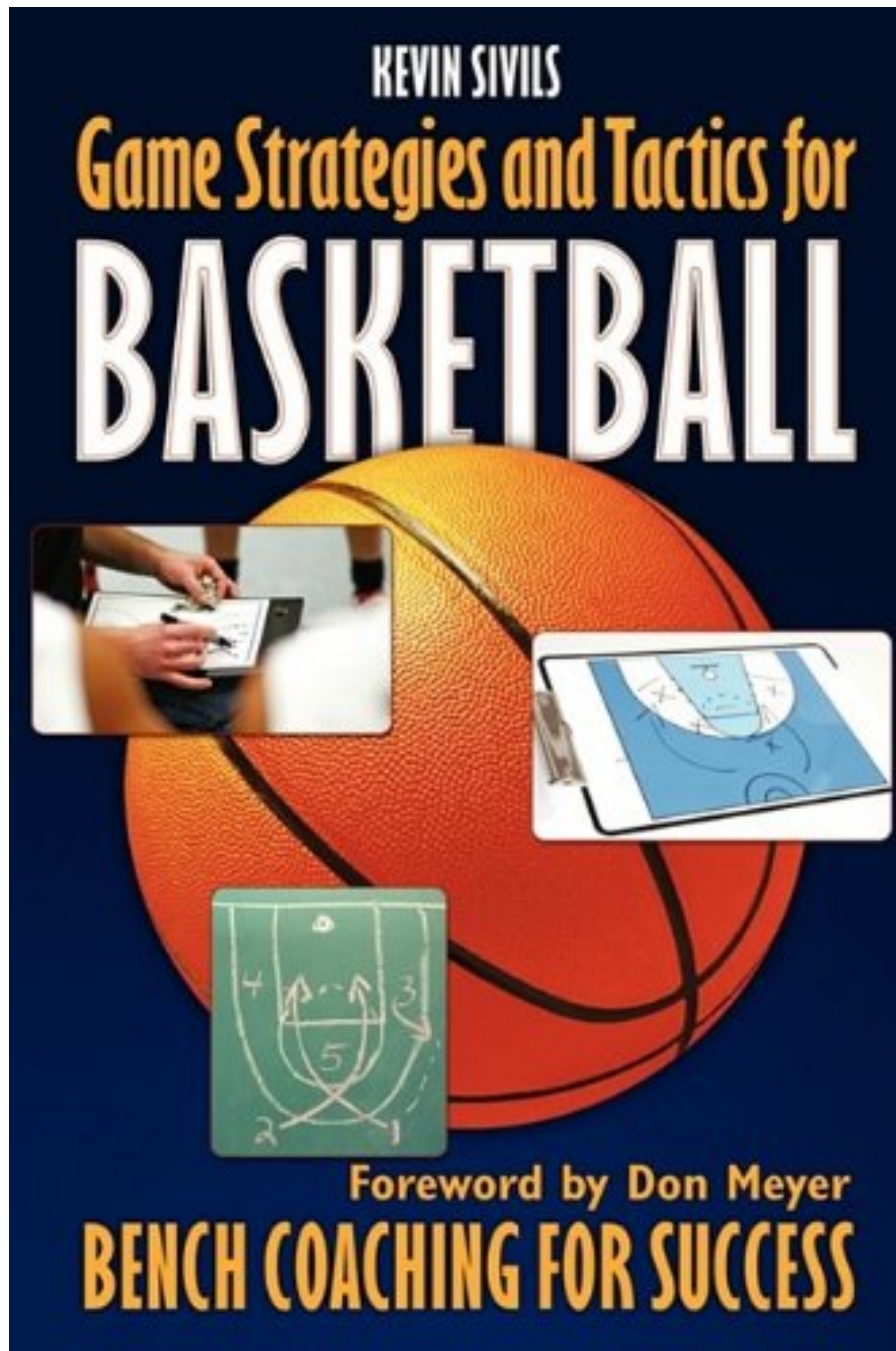

This book offers a great collection of practical tips and tricks for a successful basketball game at an intermediate level and above. The advice is primarily targeted to a coach rather than a team or a player, however it is very useful for players as well. Most of the advice is not particularly novel, just a great summary of what is already known, but as George Orwell tells us "the best books... are those that tell you what you know already." Being a beginner basketball player, I found this book somewhat overwhelming, might get back to it in a year or two :-). The book also has a suggested reading list at the back (which I intend to go through). Some of my favourite quotes:
